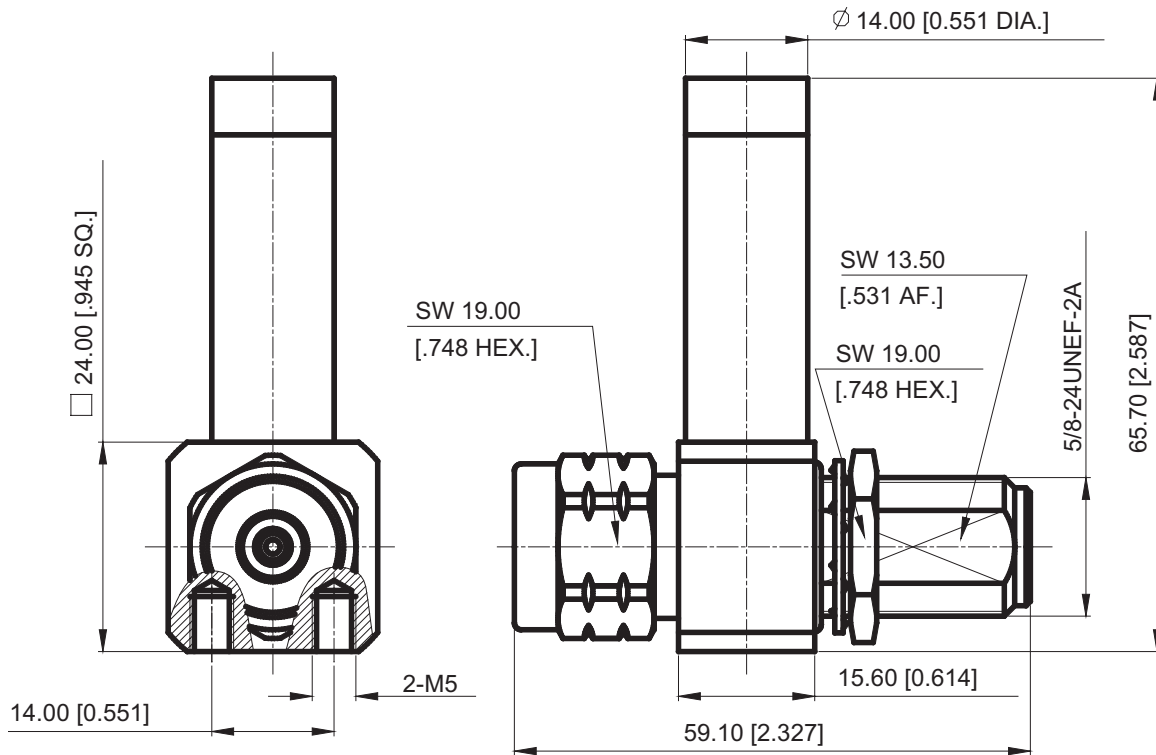

## 3. ATTENTIONS IN OPERATIONS

- The protector should be placed at the input to the installation and preferably near sensitive equipment.
- All protectors to be installed must be interconnected and connected with equipotential ground network.
- In order to minimize the residual voltages, the screws (M5x6) should be tightened up and the connection of the protector to the ground network should be as short as possible (less than 50cm) and has the largest possible cross-sectional area (at least 4mm<sup>2</sup>).
